### Rules and Regulations for the use of Sugar Creek and Stoney Community Pools

Safety is our highest priority. All persons -- including residents of Sugar Creek, Sugar Creek Community Pool affiliate families, swim team staff and swimmers, and other guests -- must respect and abide by these rules.

Pool operations are under the direction of the pool committees, the pool management company, and the lifeguards on duty. Security and enforcement assistance is provided by our community Deputy.

Pools will generally be open for use according to published schedules. Pools may be closed at any time as required by DHEC, for maintenance or mechanical reasons, for weather or safety reasons, for swim meets, or as otherwise determined by pool management. Each pool has a specific capacity; if at capacity, a pool may not be able to accommodate additional persons.

Persons at the pool are expected to behave safely and appropriately at all times. Anyone not behaving appropriately will be asked to leave. Repeat offenders will be denied future use of the pool facilities.

No running, shoving, rough-housing, or horse-play. No diving except in designated areas of the pool.

No loud music, shouting, or foul language. No glass containers of any kind on the pool deck.

Families are allowed to bring up to two family members, or house guests who are not local residents, space permitting. Pool management may restrict or relax guest policy depending on the number of persons at the pool.

Use of the pool facilities is limited to residents and Pool affiliate membership families. Non-residents of Sugar Creek must purchase a Pool Membership each summer to use the facilities or participate on the swim teams.

Periodically, the staff or Deputy will check IDs against the resident and Community Pool Pass lists. Be prepared to show valid ID on request.

Show courtesy and respect for the lifeguards and staff and others at the pool so that everyone can enjoy using the facilities.

Sugar Creek HOA and Stoney Creek HOA corporations assume NO responsibility, and no members, guests, or pool pass holders shall have any claim against any of the HOA corporations for accidents, injuries or for property brought into or left on the corporation premises.
