* TENNIS RULES & REGULATIONS *

THE WOODY CREEK TENNIS COURTS ARE AVAILABLE FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF WOODY CREEK RECREATION ASSOCIATION MEMBERS & GUESTS.

The courts are locked. The white plastic card is needed for entree and exit. To open the gate facing the club house parking lot, insert the arrow end of the card in the card reader and push the gate open. The gate will automatically close once you have entered. NOTE: YOU WILL NEED TO INSERT YOUR CARD INTO THE CARD READER TO GET OUT. IF YOU ARE THE ONLY CARD HOLDER IN A GROUP AND HAVE TO LEAVE, MAKE SURE YOU GIVE YOUR CARD TO SOMEONE ELSE.

For night play, the light switch is located on the tennis court fence next to the pool house. PLEASE TURN THE LIGHTS OFF WHEN LEAVING THE COURTS.

GENERAL RULES

- * The courts are only to be used for playing tennis.
- * Only persons involved in playing tennis are allowed on the courts.
- * A maximum of four players are allowed on each court.
- * All players must wear Tennis shoes & proper tennis attire. Jogging, street or deck shoes are not allowed.
- * Players, 16 years or older have priority over minors. They can require minors to stop play and leave the courts.
- * Official organized activities sponsored by W.C.R. have first priority for use of courts.

RESERVATIONS

- * Reservations are made by entering the time & player's name on the sign-up sheet located on the tennis court fence next to the pool house. Reservations can only be made within 48 hours of play.
- * The length of time a court can be reserved is 2 hours.
- * A court cannot be reserved by the same group for two consecutive periods.
- * Reservations are to be crossed out or erased if the match is canceled.
- * Courts can be held up to 15 minutes past the reserved time when waiting on a player.
- * Contact the Tennis Committee Chairman if sign-up sheets are not available.

ANY EXCEPTIONS TO THESE RULES MUST HAVE THE AUTHORIZATION FROM THE TENNIS COMMITTEE CHAIRMAN.
